Objective

Summary of key process, programs and activities

Community level:

- 1. Localizing knowledge acquired from Japan to Iloilo.
- 2. Establishing a network of knowledge and technical resource both in Japan and in Iloilo.
- 3. Conducted community profiling.
- 4. Production of IEC material catering to the PWDs.
- 5. Conduct simulation exercises and trainings.
- 6. Digital record keeping of all programs and activities.

City level:

- 1. Mainstreaming DRR in many departments.
- 2. Identifying specific roles for prevention and response in each department.
- 3. Passing 8 city ordinances to support PWD-inclusive DRR programs.
- 4. Implementation of monitoring and evaluation of programs and activities.
- 5. Rewarding success stories.
