### EXPECTED OUTCOMES

- 2) Awareness and Preparedness on climate change, Disaster Risk Reduction (DRR) and Disability Inclusive Disaster Risk Reduction (DIDRR) are raised and made in ASEAN Community
- 3) Collaboration on making peaceful, secure, stable and resilient Region by ASEAN Member States, Thailand and Japan is strengthened
- 4) Potential trainers who from different sectors are ready to work on DiDRR effectively in their respect countries

# Adjusted Plan during COVID-19 Pandemic

Latest schedule is adjusted as follows:

First Training course: the first training is divided to 2 courses

- Online training course > 23<sup>rd</sup> (Sat) to 29<sup>th</sup> (Fri) July, 2022
- In-person training course > 5<sup>th</sup> (Sun) to 11 (Sat) February, 2023

Second Training course: 2-week in-person training > 9<sup>th</sup> (Sun) to 22<sup>nd</sup> (Sat) July 2023

Third Training course: Tentatively 2-week in the beginning of next year
